4	School Update	
	The school is currently advertising for an economist and finance manager (due to the	
	restructuring of the team). Two sports assistants have been recruited and are moving into	
	no. 11. They will assist the PE Department by running fixtures, refereeing etc. and will also	
	be able to support the boys by helping to cover lessons and supporting trips e.g. the Year 7	
	Great Yews Camping.

	and the Breacons (Gold DoE). All were enjoyed, very successful and there weren't too	
	many injuries!	
	Work is continuing with the general tidying up of the site. Over 100 lights have been	
	replaced in the sports hall in readiness for exam season.	
	Planning permission has been granted for a mobile classroom next to the science block as	
	extra science accommodation is required before a more permanent solution can be found.
