Global refugee patterns

1. Use Table 1 to draw a pie chart. Give it a title and a key. Paste it into your document and write two sentences to summarise what the data shows about where refugees are in the world.
2. Complete Tables 2 and 3 by calculating the number of refugees as a % of each country's population. In each case, which country has the highest %?
3. Use Table 4 to draw one bar chart with two bars for each country: one for refugees and one for IDPs. Give it a title and a key, and make sure the axes have labels. Paste it into your document and write two sentences to compare the two sets of data.
4. Use Table 5 to draw an appropriate graph/chart. Give it a title and labelled axes. Paste it into your document and write two sentences to summarise what the data shows about the change in numbers of refugees crossing the Mediterranean.
5. Use Table 6 to draw an appropriate graph/chart. Give it a title and labelled axes/key as appropriate. Paste it into your document and write two sentences to summarise what the data shows about the make up of refugees crossing the Mediterranean.
