Intermediate Spanish Part 2

Aims and required staring level

This course is designed for students who have completed the Intermediate Spanish Part 1 course, and for those who feel their Spanish is somewhat rusty and wish to re-visit and developed their knowledge of grammar and consolidate and expand their vocabulary and understanding of the Spanish language and culture.

Working methods/types of activities

- Reading and discussing books and articles about Spanish culture as reading offers the opportunity to practice comprehension and correct pronunciation.
- Time is set aside for conversation practice.
- Most weeks notes are given out to help the revision of grammatical points.
