Year 10 Sexual Health and Contraception Talk - Thursday 3 October 2019

Our School Health Nurse will be coming into Bishop Wordsworth's School on Thursday 3 October 2019 to deliver talks to the Year 10 boys concerning sexual health and contraception.

The aim of the session will be to encourage young people to have a positive approach to their sexual health. Evidence shows that young people between the ages of 16-24 years continue to have the highest rates of sexually transmitted infections (STI) with Chlamydia remaining the most prevalent STI in England with rates substantially higher in 15-24 year olds than any other age group. This talk from the School Health Nurse aims to provide additional education, information and support for our boys.

The talks will be held in the Drama Studio in tutor groups and the day will run as follows:
