Dear Parents/Guardians

I am writing to let you know about some additional Physics sessions that we will be offering during Year 11 which we think will be of benefit to your son. These sessions are being recommended to those boys who we feel would benefit from some extra input to help build their confidence in preparation for the prelim and future summer exams.

The sessions will focus on work covered in Years 9 and 10 and will involve a recap of the work and study of past paper questions. The intention is that, after receiving this additional support, your son will have a clearer understanding of how he can continue to work independently after the sessions have finished and improve his exam technique. A number of boys have taken advantage of these sessions during the last academic year and it was evident to us that it was a beneficial exercise.

The Physics sessions will take place on Monday lunchtimes from 12.00pm – 12.25pm and will begin on **Monday 30 September** in the Science Classroom. Below is an outline of the topic we will be covering each session. Your son will be given a pack of topic summary sheets which we ask that they try to complete prior to the session so they are well prepared for us to answer any questions they may have and give extra advice and tips.
