Money

Packing

Due to space limitations in the coach, each student should only bring one suitcase/holdall and a day sack. We can expect the weather in Germany to be similar to the weather here for the time of year; students should bring suitable clothing for this season. A waterproof is essential. There will be a fair amount of walking, so students should have comfortable and sturdy shoes. Students may also have the opportunity to go swimming, so should bring swimming trunks. They also need to bring with them towels for both swimming and using in the hostel.
