Argentina 2015

I write to you now with under 3 weeks before we depart for Argentina. The preparation for the tour has gone well and we now look set to have an enjoyable yet demanding two weeks of rugby.

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to our final meeting on **Friday 3 July** at **7.00 pm** in the **Dining Hall** and inform you about some important issues and arrangements that have been and will be put into place before, during and after the tour.

All forms have been signed and returned, and <u>I now need all passports to be handed in along with Yellow</u> Fever certificates. A finalised itinerary will be included in the pack at the meeting.
