## Year 10 - An Inspector Calls - Mayflower Theatre 5 April 2016

As you are aware, your son is studying *An Inspector Calls* for his GCSE in English Literature and the Mayflower Theatre, Southampton are hosting the National Theatre's landmark production in April 2016, during the Easter Holidays. They are applying a school discount to the evening performance on 5<sup>th</sup> April.

This production of *An Inspector Calls* is "hailed as the theatrical event of our generation winning more awards than any other play in history" and "has thrilled audiences in the West End, on Broadway and throughout the world with its epic and wildly imaginative staging, raw emotion, evocative score, lashing rain and chilling suspense". Apart from supporting his studies, this is an ideal opportunity for your son to see a five star live performance.
