# YEAR 8 CHINESE AT BWS - INVITATION TO TASTER SESSION

I am very pleased to inform you that there will be a new Chinese class for Year 8 on Tuesdays after school 4-5pm, starting in September 2016.

There will have to be a minimum of 15 students for the class to run and places will be limited to one class with a maximum capacity of 30. Pupils and parents should be aware that Chinese would be a third foreign language and the expectation is that pupils will study Chinese through to GCSE. Commitment and motivation will need to be high. Homework will be set weekly.

Regrettably the only way we can preserve the teaching of Chinese as an extra-curricular subject at BWS is for it to be a paid for activity. Therefore, there will be a charge of £225.50 made to partially offset the costs of tuition and learning resources for 2016-17. In addition there will be a text book and workbook required at the start of the year which are likely to cost around £17.00. The School reserves the right to withdraw the course if insufficient boys sign up to make it financially viable.

Mrs Tang has organised a brief taster session for boys who have been selected to learn Chinese on **Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2016** from **12:15 to 12:40** in **W6**. A form is attached for you both to complete and return if he would like to take up Chinese in Year 8.
