Points to Note:

- You need to arrive at BWS by 1400 for a 1430 departure
- Pre-expedition checks at lunch-time on, Monday 4 July for the blue group and the red group on Tuesday 5 July at 12pm
- Tents and Trangias can be signed out before departure
- The first two nights the groups will be at a campsite at Harford Bridge Park, Peter Tavy, Tavistock, Devon, PL19 9LS. Tel: 01822 810349. Grid reference SX 69 4912. Staff will remain at Harford Bridge for the duration of the expedition
- No drinking alcohol. Anyone suspected of drinking will be collected by a parent/guardian
- There will be an opportunity to do a supermarket shop on Thursday morning and I suggest a pub dinner on Wednesday evening, students to pay
- Any excess kit may be left in the trailer for the duration of the expedition, small bag for first couple of days, fresh clothes for return journey
- No ipods (or similar) please, and all mobile phones are to be sealed for use in emergencies only as this is can cause a groups immediate failure
- For wildcamping you are responsible for paying for your camp site fees
- A reminder that your 'emergency food pack' will be checked by the assessor! eg spare hot food pouch, snacks, nuts, boiled sweets, chocolate, kendal mint cake or similar
- Remember to bring your DofE keeping track booklets for completion by the assessor after your groups verbal presentation
- Participants MUST be self-sufficient for the duration of the expedition (Wednesday-Monday)
- There will be an opportunity for supper before we return to BWS on Monday, again make sure you have funds available
- You will be reminded to call home with an e.t.a.
- On arrival at BWS it is essential that all borrowed kit is taken home, trangias cleaned and tents aired and dried. If it is not returned the group will be charged for a replacement
- Also beware of ticks
