I hope your son has settled well into the final year in Middle School at BWS, a busy and challenging year before moving on to post-16 education.

Your son's Grade report will be issued on Thursday 20 October and further important dates for the coming year are listed below for your information.

GCSE exams are likely to begin at the start of May and continue into June. Towards the end of June, closely following the last exam, there will be a book collection day (date to be confirmed). It is <u>essential</u> that all boys attend, in full uniform, to return all their text books, other department educational material and their school locker padlocks. They will be 'free' to leave at approximately lunchtime. All boys are officially on roll with BWS until <u>the end of June</u>. No absences will be sanctioned during this time.

On Thursday **24 August 2017**, from 10.00 – 11.00 am, GCSE examination results will be issued and BWS Sixth form places will be confirmed. On Friday **25 August 2017** boys must come into school for confirmation of their options for BWS Sixth form.

If your son intends to study at BWS post - 16 it is essential that he attends <u>in person</u> on these two days.
