# Use the Year 11 IGCSE Revision Checklists

Boys will be given a Revision checklist in each of the Sciences before prelims. These checklists will contain a breakdown of the specification under different topic headings. These resources outline what needs to be learnt in each subject. Studying these checklists can be useful at revision time. Just reading them and trying to learn some of the facts will help gain marks in the examination. Lots of the examination questions are lifted directly from the specification! Links to these documents will be found on the school website from November for any boy who has lost their checklist.

## We spoke to the class of 2015 - What advice did they give to future year 11 students?

- Do lots of past papers •
- Buy a revision book
- Make short, concise revision notes as early as possible, learn them and get friends, family to test you and talk it over
- Start revising early
- Use your textbook and revision guide
- Focus well in the lessons and it will reduce the amount of revision needed
- Listen often what the teacher says is more important than what is written down and gives further in-depth knowledge of the topic
- Constant revision is key
- Ask your teacher for help they will go through it with you

Boys will be doing past paper questions from the beginning of September in lessons or for homework with increasing focus on past paper questions as we approach the exams. The use of exam paper questions both within class and at home has a very positive impact on the performance of the boys as it helps develop their knowledge, understanding and build confidence. Papers and mark schemes will be made available during the year on the Q drive in the subject folder eq: for Chemistry look in Chemistry-Year 11-IGCSE papers. We strongly recommend that boys have access to the remote desk top from home so that they can access these past papers and other resources.
