I wanted to write to you to give an update on the tour. The figures are set at 37 players and 5 staff with Mr Oldham joining us, who I know is looking forward to working with the Y12 boys again after last season.

I wanted to take a moment also to formally thank the parents and boys who have made huge efforts to contribute to the squads fund raising. With some hugely successful events including a fashion show and wine tasting, the Christmas market stall, match day refreshments, bag packing and individual sponsors we are well on our way to our initial target of £10,000. With more bag packing and other events in the pipeline there is more to come in, but at the moment less a few sponsors, and the Christmas stall we are at £5000ish profit.

However due to Brexit and the fall of the pound against the Australian dollar our cost to the tour company has increased by £145 per head which although a frustrating blow, is one of those things we have a contingency pot for. Nonetheless highly disappointing. To alleviate part of the problem the staff have committed to raising their own individual sponsors to go along with the boys and I will be speaking to the boys again regarding their efforts to ensure we have plenty in the 'extras pot'.

Please could I also remind you that the final balance for the trip is due by the 28 February 2017.

With GCSE prelims upon us shortly and A level prelims after Christmas the boys attentions I am sure are turning toward their studies as well as the final few games of the season. Once we return in the New Year it will be 6 months until we depart and so time for a concerted effort to increase the fundraising pot.
