NASA Florida Trip 21 - 27 October 2017

The Physics Department is planning to organise the following visit for Year 11, 12 and 13 pupils (current year 10 and 11 who intend to study A level Physics and current year 12 already doing so). The trip is to visit Florida over the Half Term in October 2017. This is the first time this trip is being offered and there is an exciting itinerary for the trip. Provisionally the dates are as follows; departure on 21 October returning on the 27 October 2017.

The approximate plan at this stage is that the trip will take seven days including travel time. The first three days in Florida will be spent at The Kennedy Space Centre at Cape Canaveral where students will take part in engineering tasks as well as other enrichment activities. The next day will involve visiting Universal Studios Orlando. (The first letter that was sent out included a second day at Universal Studios but that has been removed to reduce costs). The day before departure will be a day in the Everglades.

The logistics will be organised with the assistance of Educating Adventures, a company with a successful track record of organising similar trips. A representative from this organisation will be present every day in Florida to help the trip run smoothly.

Because of the restrictions on entering the USA all students will need an ESTA (visa waiver program) and e-passports (passports with an integrated chip). To ensure the trip runs smoothly a copy of the ESTA will also need to be brought to me next term.
