As the term comes to an end, it is an excellent opportunity to inform you of our expectations - which we have recently communicated to your sons - for the forthcoming mock examinations in January. We do expect every student to commit to sufficient independent revision time over the holiday period and we require all Sixth Form students to draw up revision timetables for the holiday period. Students have sent a copy to their mentors and we have also suggested that they share their schedules with you as well. During the period of the mock examinations (Wednesday 4 January - Tuesday 10 January inclusive) students will be on study leave and normal lessons and registration will be suspended. Private study facilities remain available in School. All students return to normal lessons on Wednesday 11 January - Year 13 students at 0845, Year 12 students at 1040.

The final UCAS deadline is 15 January but any late applications need to be received by the Sixth Form Office here by 6 January for processing.

Year 12 reports have been issued to students this week and parents will have an opportunity to meet staff at the Parents Evening on Monday 6 February from 5pm - 7.30pm. SWGS will also be holding a meeting on this evening and further details about both events will follow in January.
