- **Wednesday 1 February 2017 1.00pm Higher Education talk for students**

This will provide parents with details of the Higher Education Applications Procedure and an update on the current situation. As a student specific talk is to be held as part of the Year 12 Preparation Package earlier on this day, this talk is aimed at parents only. This event will take place in the Sixth Form Centre.*

- **Wednesday 8 February 2017 10.40am – 3.50pm B2B (Bishop's to Business)**

Year 12 will be taking part in an event focusing on School Leaver Programmes, Apprenticeships, (including Higher and the new Degree initiatives) and engaging with a range of employers both local and national. Enterprise will also be covered.

- **Thursday 9 February 2017 7.00pm - 8.30pm Applying to Oxford and Cambridge Universities**

Students and parents are invited to attend a talk given by Dr Andrew Bell, University College, Oxford. There will be an opportunity to ask questions after the presentation. Dr Bell is an Admissions Tutor and has worked at both Universities. This event will take place in the Sports Hall and is also open to a number of local schools.*

- **Friday 10 February 2017 8.45am – 3.30pm 'Your Choice-Your Future' HE and Careers Event**

With over 37,000 courses offered by over 340 Higher Education institutions, making decisions about the future can be daunting. This day will consist of a series of workshops and presentations tailored to the needs of our students in Year 12 with a centrepiece exhibition in our Sports Hall. A very 'hands-on' approach will help Year 12s begin their university research in a pro-active way. Those wanting to move in other directions are well catered for too, with information about Apprenticeships, gap years and employment opportunities.

The emphasis on this day is not so much on the pros and cons of studying at the specific institution but on how to make effective choices of both courses and institutions once the UCAS process is underway in September.
