The English Department is planning to organise a visit to the Barbican to see a Royal Shakespeare performance of *The Tempest*. In collaboration with Intel, this should be a stunning visual as well as audio performance. Simon Russell Beale plays Prospero and the play is directed by Gregory Doran. *The Tempest* is one of the key components of the A Level course and this Royal Shakespeare production will contribute to the students' appreciation of the play.
