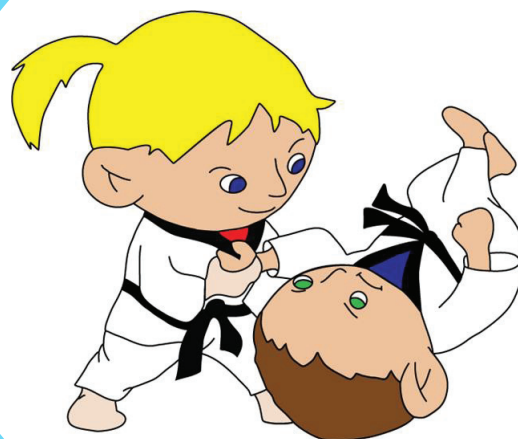
...fancy an *enjoyable* evening with your son?!

...how much do Mums and Sons really know about each other?

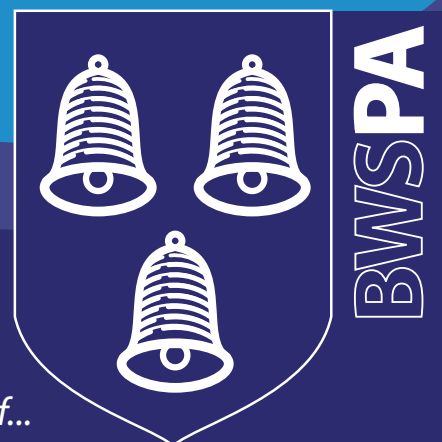

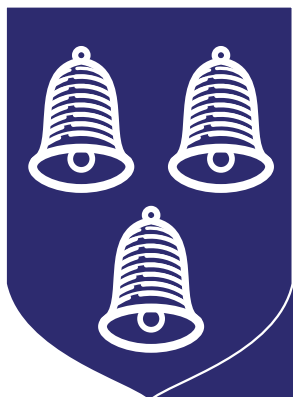
