Dear Parents/Guardians

As we are nearing the final of the NatWest Cup Final on Wednesday 29 March, I am writing to confirm the final details to ensure that all students understand the logistics, conditions and requirements they need to adhere to at Twickenham to make it a successful day for Bishop Wordsworth's School. *Please can you ensure you communicate the arrangements below to your son prior to Wednesday.*

ASSEMBLY AREAS FOR TWICKENHAM:

ASSEMBLY POINT 1: NORTH CAR PARK

ASSEMBLY POINT 2: GATE C

ASSEMBLY POINT 3: ROWS L6 - L8 (PROPOSED AREA TO BE SEATED - SUBJECT TO

CHANGE)

On arrival at Twickenham, pupils will need to stay within their coach groups once disembarking at **ASSEMBLY POINT 1: NORTH CAR PARK**. The welcome party consisting of Mr Churchill, Mr Thorne, Mr Harmsworth and the BWS Sixth Form Prefects will guide the groups from the North Car Park to **ASSEMBLY POINT 2: – GATE C.**

Staff and students will then be transferred through the stadium gates to be seated in the proposed seating arrangements: **ASSEMBLY POINT 3: WEST STANDS LOWER 6 – 8.**

It is imperative that your son stays within their appointed coach group whilst transferring between assembly areas. Once they are assigned to their seating areas then they are free to move about within the BWS seating arrangements, however if they would like to either buy food, drinks or use the toilet facilities then they must travel within a group of 3 minimum. Students will be responsible for looking after their personal possessions and must not leave their bags unattended at any time.

Your son will <u>not</u> be allowed to sit on any other levels within the stadium or be allowed to go outside the stadium gates. As it is a school event the England RFU will not be serving alcohol or tolerate any individuals in possession of this or any other contraband.

FIRST AID PROVISION:

Apart from the Twickenham stadium first aid provision, Mr Churchill and Mr Thorne will be the appointed first aiders on the day and all staff and students will be advised as to where they will be situated within the proposed seating areas. Please ensure that we have current emergency contact details and details of any medical conditions and that your son takes all necessary medication with him on this trip.

It is important to note however that within the stands are other upcoming groups of talented BWS rugby players and with the determination and enthusiasm shown at Britford lane, there is no reason for Bishop Wordsworth's School Rugby to not always be at the top of the National schools competitions in future years.
