I am writing with reference to the forthcoming visit to St. Ives, from **Monday 19 June – Thursday 22 June 2017**.

Thank you for paying the deposit of £100. The final instalment of £90 is due by Monday 8 May.

We will be travelling down to St. Ives by minibus, and will be departing BWS (Exeter St. car park) at **09:00am** on Monday 19 June and returning around **18:00pm** on Thursday 22 June. Please can you provide your son with a drink and packed lunch for the initial journey.
