The BWS ski trip 2018 will travel to Winter Park, one of most highly rated resorts in North America at <u>Easter 2018</u>. The trip will be arranged by Equity who provided a fantastic trip to Tignes this year. This trip is open to the current Year 9 pupils and upwards.

Winter Park offers high altitude skiing and is renowned for its 'Champagne Powder' (over 29ft annually). The terrain is varied and will suit all levels of ability ranging from a 30 acre Discovery Park for beginners, to the steep moguls and precipitous glades of the Mary Jane Mountain. Snow boarders are also well catered for with 5 parks and 1 Super-pipe.

The Vintage Hotel is superbly located directly across from the ski area either by a dedicated lift or a short walk through the Village. There is easy access to the evening entertainments, which include a Cinema, Bowling and Tubing. There are also numerous shops and restaurants within walking distance.

Accommodation

Boys will be allocated spacious and comfortable two bed standard rooms that sleep 4. As with the majority of American accommodation, school party members are expected to share queen or double size beds and all are en-suite with cable-TV. The hotel boasts hot tubs, plus a fitness area and games room.

Eating Arrangements - Half-Board

The students will be provided with a continental buffet breakfast taken in the Hotel. Lunch will be supervised by the Ski Instructors and taken at various base lodges on the mountain. (Pocket money will be required. Typically \$20.00 a day will be sufficient). Evening meals will be at various eateries in Downtown Winter Park such as Smokin' Moes and Docs Roadhouse.
