Re: A Level Art Trip to London Monday 16 October 2017

The Art Department is planning to organise the following visit for all students in Years 12 and 13.

Year 13 students should by now have a clear focus for their 'Personal Investigation', which counts for 30% of their A level. This study relates to a specific title of their own choosing, and should be an extension of their own interests. This element is well underway and students need time to study from relevant artwork to support their investigation.

For Year 12, the visit is intended to help students investigate a wide range of artists and artworks, whilst exploring and developing their own tastes and interests. The visit will provide students with an opportunity to begin relevant research into their initial coursework project.
