Academic Assessment Interviews

Every boy in Year 10 will have a short interview with a senior member of staff before the end of this academic year. The intention of the interview is to gauge your son's current progress with his studies, to look ahead to Year 11 and also to briefly discuss his future plans for post-16 education. Your son will also have a second interview, with the same member of staff, at the start of the Spring Term following their Prelim Examinations.

The focus of the interview and the issues discussed will have a common thread for all, but the emphasis (of course) will vary. For those boys who are currently doing very well, we will use the opportunity to talk through where they feel that they need to focus so as to maximise their potential. Where boys are not meeting their target grades we concentrate on what they need to do throughout Year 11 so as to close the grade gap. For boys who we feel are coasting and not trying hard enough, we will obviously use the interview to focus their minds on the improvements needed.

Each interview will be informed by the outcomes of the recent Year 10 examinations and associated report. The agenda for the discussion will therefore not come as a surprise to you, and hopefully this will prove to be a valuable opportunity for your son to take stock and get some advice and guidance before he starts Year 11. The second interview will be informed by the outcomes of the Prelim examinations and the subsequent report.
