The Physics department has been able to secure 27 seats for the annual STAG lecture at Nuffield Theatre in Southampton University. This year the talk is entitled "Probing the Universe with Gravitational Waves" and will be delivered by the 2017 Physics Nobel Prize Winner Rainer Weiss who worked on the LIGO experiment that last year made the first detection of the collision of two neutrons stars. This talk should be a fantastic opportunity to take the learning of astrophysics beyond the classroom and as it matches most closely with our year 13 content we are prioritising your sons year group first.
