## **BWS READING CHALLENGE / YEAR 8 SUBJECT EXPERTS**

The idea is to generate a real passion for reading through competition, and to encourage boys to stretch themselves with regards to what they choose to read. Participants have to choose from a series of exciting challenges at Bronze, Silver and Gold levels; and house points and individual prizes are up for grabs. Again, if you are a parent of a boy in Year 8, it would be good if you could talk to them about applying – it is a great opportunity to both stand out and to work with others at a relatively early point in their school careers!
