Dear Parents/Guardians

Year 12 Reports and Consultation Evening – TUESDAY 11TH DECEMBER 2018

Year 12 Grade Reports have now been completed by subject teachers and Sixth Form Mentors, giving an early indication of your son's progress including target grade, current performance grade, and key targets for the next few months. Your son's report has been posted on the Insight system for you to review and print if you wish. Please do discuss the report with him; he will also be reflecting on it in his next Mentor meeting.

Following the report, on **Tuesday 11th December** from 5.00-7.30pm we hope you will be able to attend a **Consultation Evening** with your son to discuss his progress. In advance of this meeting, your son will arrange 5 minute appointments for you with his teachers using the appointment sheet which is attached to this email.

On arrival we ask that you sign in at the Sixth Form Study Room in the Maths Block, where the Head Master, Head of Year 12 and Careers Adviser will also be available. South Wilts Grammar School is also holding a Consultation Evening that night and so it is possible for your son to arrange meetings with his teachers there if applicable. If that is the case, he will need to arrange appointments to allow sufficient time for travel between the two sites. Regrettably, parking is not available on either site during the evening.

We hope every parent will be able to attend this Consultation Evening, which is a key opportunity for teachers, students and parents to all discuss progress. Looking further ahead:

- On Wednesday 30th January Mrs Armstrong, our Independent Careers Consultant will speak to Year 12 Parents about Higher Education and other options beyond sixth form.
- Our Higher Education and Careers Conference is on Friday 15th February with more than 50 universities and over 20 employers in the Sports Hall – boys will attend all day and parents are welcome to visit in the afternoon.
- On Monday 18th March there will be a "by-invitation" consultation after school for parents of Year 12 students about whom staff have concerns.
- Year 12 exams will take place in the week beginning 6th May – these are important for measuring progress and will be key in informing our prediction of A level grades to UCAS subsequently.
- A Full Report will be issued in mid-July.

More information will follow about each of these events, but you might like to put them in your family calendars now.

I look forward to seeing you on 11th December.
