Easter Revision for A Level at Bishop Wordsworth's School – Years 12 and 13

We are offering intensive one/two day A Level revision courses, to boys and girls, giving a structured review of core topics. These courses, delivered by exceptional tutors, will boost students' knowledge base, exam techniques and confidence in the run up to the summer exams.

Courses cost £100 per day and half-day session is £50. Students only doing the afternoon Revision sessions should arrive by 1.00 pm.

All classes will be taught in the Sixth Form Centre and courses will start at 9.30am and run through to 4.30pm (students should arrive by 9.15am).

The following subjects are available **Business Studies, Chemistry, Biology and Physics.**
