Re: Peer Education Project

The school is taking part in a programme called the Peer Education Project (PEP) designed by the Mental Health Foundation.

The programme trains older pupils to deliver mental health lessons to younger students. The aim of the programme is to give young people the skills and knowledge they need to safeguard their mental health, as well as that of their peers. At BWS, the Year 12 form prefects will deliver five 40 minute lessons to their Year 7 forms. All lessons will be supervised by a member of staff.

As your son is a form prefect, he will be attending a training session at <u>Godolphin School on</u> <u>Friday 10th May between 1:00pm and 6:30pm</u>. Food will be provided from 6:30pm - 7:00pm. Your son may stay for pizza if he wishes. The aim of the training session is to prepare the form prefects to deliver the lessons. It has been organised by Godolphin School, who are also taking part in the programme. It is your <u>son's responsibility to make his way to and from Godolphin</u> <u>School.</u>
