Dear Parents/Guardians

As you will be aware your son achieved less than 50% in their Yr10 Chemistry exam. We therefore feel that they would be wise to spend a little time consolidating the Yr9 and Yr10 Chemistry work to provide them with a more solid foundation on which to build next year.
