Your son has been identified as a pupil who would benefit from some extra academic support with his mathematical studies. This has been based on his performance during the previous academic year, including his End of Year exam result.

Therefore, starting in September, we would like your son to take part in our academic support programme in which he will be paired up with a Year 12 mentor (all carefully selected from our A level Mathematics' students) who will provide him with a weekly lunchtime session in which they can complete some extra work provided by his teacher, and help in any areas of mathematics in which he is struggling.

In previous years, this has proved to be of great benefit to our boys, both building their confidence in the subject and providing them with a point of contact, other than their teacher, whom they can approach for help. **Membership of this scheme requires commitment from your son to attend one weekly lunchtime session.** 

We hope that you and your son will fully support us with this programme, and that we will all see the benefits in the months to follow.
