Re: Rockbourne Trout Fishery Angling Trip - June 2019

Due to the popularity of our now annual Angling trip to Manningford Trout Fishery, I am pleased to offer an alternative opportunity for a small number of boys to visit another local Fishery. This was again very popular last year and is another chance for boys to get out once more. I would like to offer these dates **to boys who have already had some experience**. I will still be going to Manningford as well and first timers will have a chance to experience fly-fishing here.

Rockbourne is only 20mins away on the way to Fordingbridge. Due to its locality I have arranged to have use of the lakes for a couple of hours after school. They have very generously offered us full use of any equipment (£40 rod charge if damaged) and essentially a two for one ticket of £20 per student, allowing them one fish to keep. I would like to go a couple of times over these Summer months if the interest is there thus boys could go on multiple occasions or just pick one date. We will be departing at 4pm and returning around 6.30pm
