Dear Parents/Guardians

With the new rugby a little over 2 months away preparations are well underway for another successful season with the small matter of Japan in the meantime.

I write to let you know of the basic outline for senior pre-season which will run for four days from the **Tuesday 27th August** through to **Thursday 29th August** and will culminate in the South Coast Kings Rugby Tournament on **Sunday 1st September** for the rugby team.

We will stay in school overnight on Tuesday until Thursday and stay in the sports hall. While in school we will utilise both our facilities onsite as well as Britford Lane. Over the duration we will have guest speakers and coaches in to discuss teamwork, leadership, injury prevention and nutrition.

We will also go out to the New Forest Water Park as part of a team bonding exercise one evening. Boys should come prepared for this along with their training kit and casual clothes for evenings

The rough days and timings are below, but are yet to be finalised, but to cover the cost of preseason I am asking each player to pay £25 towards the cost.

Boys need to budget £20 maximum for their food while staying in school – which they will be responsible for sourcing and cooking using the school cookery room.

The boys already have gym programmes and will also have running work they have been doing and it will be essential this is maintained and built upon throughout August when we do not have contact time until the end. If they can get a month's gym membership this would be beneficial, alternatively all exercises can be done as body weight exercises.
