Cologne/Rheinland Trip, 8th- 12th June 2020

The German Department is delighted to propose a trip to Cologne and the Rheinland from 8th to 12th June 2020. The trip will be open to pupils studying German in Year 10 (GCSE) and Year 9 (first language) and will be an opportunity to experience the language first-hand, thereby supporting their classroom learning and giving them opportunities to practise their German in real-life situations.

The trip will include visits to Cologne Cathedral, the Cologne Chocolate Museum, Bonn, Koblenz (cable car/ Marksburg Castle), Phantasia Land theme park and a River Rhein cruise which will take in castles, Loreley Rock and a visit to Rudesheim. We will be travelling to Cologne by coach and staying in a youth hostel in Cologne on a full-board basis.

The trip is being arranged through a specialist group tour operator Rayburn Tours who are ABTA bonded and ATOL protected. There are 40 places available for this trip and receipt of the deposit will be taken to mean you wish to take up a place on the trip. The total cost may vary depending on uptake, but will not run without sufficient interest. However, in the event that the trip is oversubscribed, 40 names will be drawn at random and those pupils who are unsuccessful will be placed on a reserve list and their deposits refunded.

All pupils require a current passport, valid for six months after the date of return, and a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).
