Mark	Grade	Description
10	A*	Writing is effective and developed; and shows a good awareness of its reader's response. Sentences and paragraphs are controlled confidently. Spelling and punctuation is accurate, and there are some successful attempts to use punctuation to enhance meaning.
8/9	A	Writing is secure and develops details; there is some awareness of the need to adapt to the reader. Sentence structure and paragraphing are varied appropriately. Spelling and punctuation are generally accurate, perhaps with some misspelling of more complex irregular words; and there is some awareness of punctuation for meaning.
6/7	B	Writing is clear; and there is some attempt to go into detail and manipulate reader response. Spelling of most common complex words is secure, and most sentences have accurate sentence demarcation.
4/5	C	Most of the writing is clear and there are some attempts to manipulate reader response. More complex words are generally spelled correctly, and there is evidence of grasping the basics of sentence demarcation.
0-3	D	Some of the writing is clear, although there may not be attempts to manipulate reader response. Simple words and spelled correctly, although not necessarily common complex words. Some sentence demarcation is correct.
