# ANDALUCIA - A LEVEL STUDY TOUR 13 - 19 February 2018

The Spanish Department is planning to organise the above visit for Year 12 and 13 pupils. This is a fantastic opportunity to experience first-hand all the cultural highlights of Andalucia which are based on the required A level Spanish themes in a tailor-made study tour organised by Babelyus, a specialist organisation we have been using since 2007. It will also offer non-stop opportunities to practise Spanish language, especially speaking skills.

The cost of the trip includes:

- All airport transfers and school travel insurance cover
- Return flights to Seville from Gatwick
- A 6 night, 7 day stay in a 3\* hotel in a central location in Seville
- All meals (some in restaurants/tapas bars as part of the experience/some as buffet meals in the hotel)
- 2 full day trips to Granada and Córdoba

All activities and visits are also included:

- Learning activities including spending time with a group of A level students in their school and doing language activities with them
- A theatre session on Lorca, visiting his birthplace near Granada (as preparation for studying his play "La casa de Bernada Alba" in school)
- A Flamenco show and workshop with a professional expert, fun and practical language lessons and more
- Visits to the architectural jewels of Andalucia including the Mezquita in Cordoba, the Alcazar and Cathedral, the Plaza de España, the Triana district and market and modern places of interest in Seville.

The total cost of the trip will be between £870 - £920 depending on numbers.

# Provisional Itinerary for 6<sup>th</sup> Form Spanish Cultural Trip to Andalucía <u>13 – 18 February 2018</u>

#### Tuesday 13 February 2018 (Day 1)

Depart 9.35 am/arrival Seville airport 13.20 Easyjet Transfer to hotel, lunch Tour of area near hotel, language exercise Tapas meal in evening (Seville is the home of tapas in the 15<sup>th</sup> century)

#### Wednesday 14 February 2018 (Day 2)

Buffet breakfast in hotel Map class/activities Bus to Córdoba Meal in a typical Cordoban restaurant Guided tour of the Mezquita, one of the architectural wonders of the Andalucian world Tour of Córdoba Buffet dinner in hotel

#### Thursday 15 February (Day 3)

Buffet breakfast in hotel Theatre workshop on Lorca (Andalucian poet, playwright, musician and artist killed at the start of the Spanish Civil War), writer of set book "La Casa de Bernada Alba" Visit the Alcázar in Seville (Royal Palace, every room tells the story of a different century, also gardens) Lunch in restaurant in Seville Visit the cathedral in Seville Plaza de España, photo activity (beautiful square made for 1929 expo) Setas iluminadas (modern installation, lit up at night - to explore in the city) Buffet dinner in hotel

# Friday 16 February (Day 4)

Buffet breakfast in hotel Bus to Granada. Visit the summer residence of Lorca and his birthplace in Fuentevaqueros (Granada) Tour of Granada, shopping Return to Seville by bus. Dinner in hotel

# Saturday 17 February (Day 5)

Buffet breakfast in hotel Visit to Spanish school with 6<sup>th</sup> form students, reception in school, music, dance, interviews and breakfast with the Spanish students Flamenco class with maestro Juan Paredes Picnic lunch Free time for shopping Dinner in typical restaurant Flamenco Master Class and show in the Museum of Flamenco in Seville (the best centre for real Flamenco, not a tourist version)

#### Sunday 18 February (Day 6)

Buffet breakfast Triana market: chocolate and churros exercise Return to hotel – packing and preparations for return
