Spring 2018 Mullins Memorial Lecture 7pm 12 March 2018 at BWS

Alan Rusbridger "Fake News. Post News. No News. What is the future for information and democracy?"



On Monday 12 March 2018 Bishop Wordsworth's School welcomes Alan Rusbridger to deliver the Sixth Annual Mullins Lecture.

Alan Rusbridger first joined *The Guardian* as a reporter in 1979 and, after stints working for *The Observer* and the *London Daily News*, became Editor of *The Guardian* in 1995 – a post that he then held for 17 years. During that time he oversaw dramatic changes to the national media and also introduced the digital platform for the national newspaper. On stepping down from leading *The Guardian* Alan was appointed Principal at Lady Margaret Hall, Oxford.

The 2018 Mullins Lecture will start at 7.00pm at the school, with light refreshments available from 6.15pm and a question and answer session at the end.
