Bishop Wordsworth's School is delighted to be supporting the Wooden Spoon Schools 2017/18 Campaign at the Bryanston U15 & U18 Rugby 7s Tournament on 11 March.

Wooden Spoon is the children's charity of rugby, funding life-changing projects across the UK and Ireland to support children and young people with disabilities or facing disadvantage. They fund a range of projects, which are not just rugby-focused, supporting approximately 70 projects a year including respite and medical treatment centres, sensory rooms, specialist playgrounds and community-based programmes.

Core values of passion, integrity, teamwork and fun are at the heart of everything. The Schools Campaign provides pupils with a fun experience in working together for the benefit of those less fortunate than themselves. The aim is to have 10,000 students wearing the distinctive Wooden Spoon stripy socks during the 2017/18 season.

Bishop Wordsworth's School has joined in with other schools, colleges and universities across the country in dressing sports teams in O'Neill's Wooden Spoon socks. Socks cost £10 per pair with £5 of this going direct to Wooden Spoon.

For those who wish to join in with the fun, but are not playing on the day there is also the opportunity to purchase Wooden Spoon dress socks, so no one has to miss out. Every penny donated to Wooden Spoon will go to supporting deserving good causes in your local area.

The socks are available to all Bishop Wordsworth's School pupils, the U15 & U18 teams will sport the Wooden Spoon socks for the occasion and all boys may wear them in games at training that week. Please make payment via Scopay including size of sock.
