## **Y8, Y10 and Y12 Mental Health Talks to Students and Parents – Thursday 5 and Friday 6 July 2018**

As part of your son's PSHE programme, we have arranged for Dick Moore to visit Bishops on Thursday 5 and Friday 6 July to discuss mental health. Dick will talk to boys in Year 12 on Thursday 5 July and boys in Year 8 and Year 10 on Friday 6 July. Each year group will spend a double period with him.

Dick has been an English teacher, rugby coach, boarding school housemaster and for over twenty years, the headmaster of a co-educational day and boarding school. Circumstances led him to develop a passionate interest in adolescent development and emotional wellbeing and he qualified as a Youth Mental Health First Aid Instructor in 2012 and became an Associate Trainer for the Charlie Waller Memorial Trust in 2013. This event does carry a significant cost so I would be grateful for a voluntary contribution of £2 if you feel that you are able to contribute.

We are also hoping to run a parent session with Dick in the evening on Thursday 5 July at 7pm which I would strongly recommend to parents. Please note that **this session is open to all parents** but boys should not attend.
